

NOTES ON COMPARATIVE AFRICAN WORDLISTS. 1 AND 2

The purpose of the series entitled Comparative African Wordlists is to make available a number of wordlists collected in connection with current studies of sound correspondences in African languages. The lists are based on a standard English questionnaire designed for the collection of a large number of root morphemes in a short time.

The items in the lists are arranged semantically, but an alphabetical index is provided in the first volume.

The first volume, by J.M. Stewart, gives wordlists for Awutu, Larteh, Nkonya and Krachi, four languages of the Guan (Guang) group, with glosses in Twi as well as in English. The second volume, by Miss M.E. Kropp, gives wordlists for Ga, Adangme and Ewe.

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
