

P r e f a c e

The papers by Addo-Fening and Arhin (pages 129 and 152) were, originally, contributions to a Seminar on "The Role of the Presbyterian Church in the Socio-economic Development of Ghana", organized jointly by the Institute of African Studies and the Presbyterian Church of Ghana and held on 23rd and 24th of February, 1979. Plans to bring out all the papers of the Seminar in one volume did not materialize; and we offer the two papers in this issue in the belief that they still have points of interest to our readers.

With the exception of the paper by Sackey (page 180) the rest of the contributions have also been with us since the late 1970's, and are being published for the same reason.
