MMOVED TO LANSING AT 19 WITH AUNT ^{lived}

HIREO IN SAME DAY AS APPLIED FEB 11 1969

PEOPLO TOLD HIM HOW LUCKY HE WAS TO HAVE ONE OF THE BEST PAYING JOBS IN LANSING

STARTED IN BODY SHOP SUPERVISION FRED BEECH WAS HIS 1ST. IT WAS VERY DEMANDING PHYSICALLY PEOPLE WERE SHOUTING AT HIM ON THE JOB AS HE WAS TRYING TO LEARN THE JOB, APPLYING PARTS TO FIXTURES TO BEGIN WITH THEN MOVED TO SPOT WELDING OR SIDE FRAMES. PROTECTIVE CLOTHING, GLASSES, NOISEY & COMMUNICATION WAS DIFFICULT YOU TALKED TO THE PERSON RIGHT NEXT TO YOU AND THAT WAS ABOUT IT AFTER WORKING 3 MONTHS HE WENT FOR A PHYSICAL THEN 3 MONTHS LATER WAS DRAFTED. DONUTS, CHIP, CANDY. PEOPLE LOVED THE WAGON. 1ST
JOB IN TRIM WAS PUTTING A DOOR RUBBER ON. I WAS
BACK TO USING MY HANDS AND IT REMINDED ME OF MY
1ST JOB, NIGHT SHIFT IN TRIM. SOFT POP AND SANDWICHES
IN TRIM SAW OTHERS DOING IT AND WENT IN WITH THE GUYS
ON DAYS. DID WELL WITH VENDING BECAUSE OF THE CONVENIENCE
PLAYED IN CHECK POOLS AND FOOTBALL POOLS BUT NEVER
WON MUCH. MAYBE ONE WON ONE FOOTBALL POOL IN MY
WHOLE TIME IN THE SHOP. HAPPIEST MOMENT WAS
WHEN I GOT MY 30 YEAR AWARD. WHEN I GOT
INVOLVED IN THE UNION I HAD SO MANY HAPPY MOMENTS.
MY WIFE GOT INVOLVED IN THE UNION AND ASKED
ME TO GET INVOLVED IN THE UNION. THEY HAD A
PROGRAM BLACK MEN IN THE UNION THAT SET THE FIRE
UNDER ME TO GET INVOLVED. I THINK MY PART
BEING A EPG LEADER HELPED WITH ME GETTING
INVOLVED.

You had to be elected to EPG. I won AGAINST A VERY popular person in my AREA. AFTER THAT I RAN FOR PRESERVATION AND VETERAN, ~~REP~~.
