In beginning, ~~Women~~ in Plant Few blocks,

Women ^{couldn't work over} 54 hours/week, 10 hours/night

Worked X-Mas eve,

Equity in gender & race came around 70's

Plant dinners - once in awhile
took up collections for babies, etc.

Pay women 10¢ less/hour, late 70's caught up
separate seniority lists

Met at work - 1955, married in 1957, collection + coffee pot.
Change overs @ work - no women worked during this time.

Forman worked on line at many times - many
215 grievances, mgt to wear white shirts to identify
Collection's taken up in groups

No annual UAW picnic

Baseball diamonds - mgt vs hourly

Diningroom was always separate

B'ld of 603 Union Hall - St Joe store front was where 1st
UAW meeting - Sold bricks \$1 each for a brick to build
the Hall. How long to build? Contracted out to build hall

53' gm car made @ plant Bought many GM products
over the years.

"Capital of Quality" - People - hard work, pride in work
people helping others. Working together

Quality of work life - Started up program for employees
to have more input into the build process.

Don Chenoweth - plant mngs - set up meeting

Drinking prevalent, not so much drugs until about 1970's
mgt and hourly alike.

Football pools, Not able to have radio or newspapers.

Name changes - Always be Fisher Body to us.

~~1985~~ 1985 model - worked out training, get older employees
out so young could continue to work.

Doreen - Chair of Election committee - Vote - Pay

Eight people 24 hours

swing shift election - 4 week days / 4 weeks nights
liked the swing shift

Most appreciated benefit - Pension + health care

Pranks

Wagon - 7-8 days out on strike, Increased line speed for 6 min break

Coffee - 54 to 74 went on boycott

No vending machines at first, later they went to vending machines in satellite areas, got rid of the wagon

Spent a lot of money promoting this issue. Union voted - turned down

Population of plant approx 6,000 people 1984 around \$5,000.

Flowers in front of Plant - made Coach symbol

Fisher Body Symbol - known as a good place to work

Shop rats - looked down upon because they were uneducated.

No Eye, hearing, prescriptions, insurance - Paid own

Joined the Union - now get these.

Harry's Bar - Went in shifts to bar to drink and eat
