Zambezia is the bi-annual journal of the University of Rhodesia and its publication has been made possible by the generous support of the Publications Committee of the University. The main focus of the journal, as its name implies, is South Central Africa; but inaugural lectures and articles of a more general interest will also be published. A series of monograph supplements to *Zambezia* is also provided to cover the main disciplines in the University (Education, Engineering, Humanities, Medicine, Science and Social Studies); and this series will not necessarily have the same regional focus as *Zambezia* itself. Ten such supplements have appeared so far; those for 1979 are on Asians in Uganda, the Production and Marketing of Fresh Produce by Africans, and an Education Supplement.
