THE EARLY HISTORY OF MALAWI

Edited by Professor B. Pachai

The papers in this volume cover a wide spread in Malawi's history from its beginnings in the Later Stone Age, through tribal conflicts, invasions and migrations, the war against the Arab slavers, to the arrival from Europe of explorers, missionaries and colonisers. The writings of a group of historians have been combined to give an overall picture of this diverse history, each contribution throwing light on a particular aspect of it.

Twenty of the papers were presented at a symposium of Malawi's history held in Blantyre in 1970; this symposium brought together academics, recognised leaders in their fields, from all parts of Africa, the U.S.A. and Britain, as well as non-professionals spurred on by their enthusiasm. The remaining four papers appear for the first time in this volume.

The Editor is Professor of History at the University of Malawi.
