ZAMBEZIA

Zambezia has been subtitled *A Journal of Social Studies in Southern and Central Africa* but the subject range of articles published has tended to become broader, as indeed can be seen from the contents of this issue, with articles on Shona literature and music. It has therefore been decided to sub-title *Zambezia* simply as *The Journal of the University of Rhodesia* to take account of the wider interests of members of the University of Rhodesia. Nevertheless the focus of the journal will remain the societies on and around the Zambezi.

Concurrently with this change of sub-title, the format of the journal will be changed to a somewhat smaller, handier size. The first issue in this new format will be the next issue, Volume 4, No. 1 with a cover date of December 1975, which will be published in April 1976; the main contents of this issue will be those papers of the Rhodesia Scientific Association's Congress in 1974 which dealt with problems of management. This issue will be followed by Volume 4, No. 2 with a cover date of December 1976 which will be published by that date, and will consist mainly of articles on social change among Rhodesian Africans. Thereafter it is hoped that there will be an annual volume published in two parts; and the Editor now invites contributions for publication in 1977.
