After the ladies had got the tables cleared and the baskets put away, the chairman of the farmers' club, Mr. Wm. Dever, invited the speakers to chairs upon the platform, and announced music by the club. Rev. Wastell, of Clinton, offered prayer, after which Chas. H. Richmond, of Ann Arbor, was introduced. He commenced by telling how the farmer's life was freed from the smoky city, from close contact with vice and crime which life promotes in crowded tenement houses and outlandish atmosphere. That the presence of the pure air of Heaven accounts for the farmer's large healthiness, that about one sixth of the people are engaged in agriculture, with a capital of one thousand millions of dollars invested, while manufacturers and mechanics had about two thousand millions of dollars invested.

He spoke of the voting power of the farmers, and called the farmers to look to the extension of government affairs. He drew comparisons between the city and farmer lands, in dress, home privies, etc., and urged the farmer to make his home attractive and give the boys every advantage. He stated that the farmers of America raised one-fifth of the crops of the world, gave the average product per acre in the various countries, and furnished statistics proving that in countries where farming is not done on a large scale the profit is larger in proportion.

Then came a song, "No time like the old time." Rev. Husted, of Clinton, said that the qualifications for a minister were that he could sing the doxology and eat chickens. The race was easily won by the last [laughter] he could do both. He said that when he was a boy he went to northern Michigan, learned how to swing an ax, plow with oxen, and could keep his temper good, even with his colored (red) neighbors.
