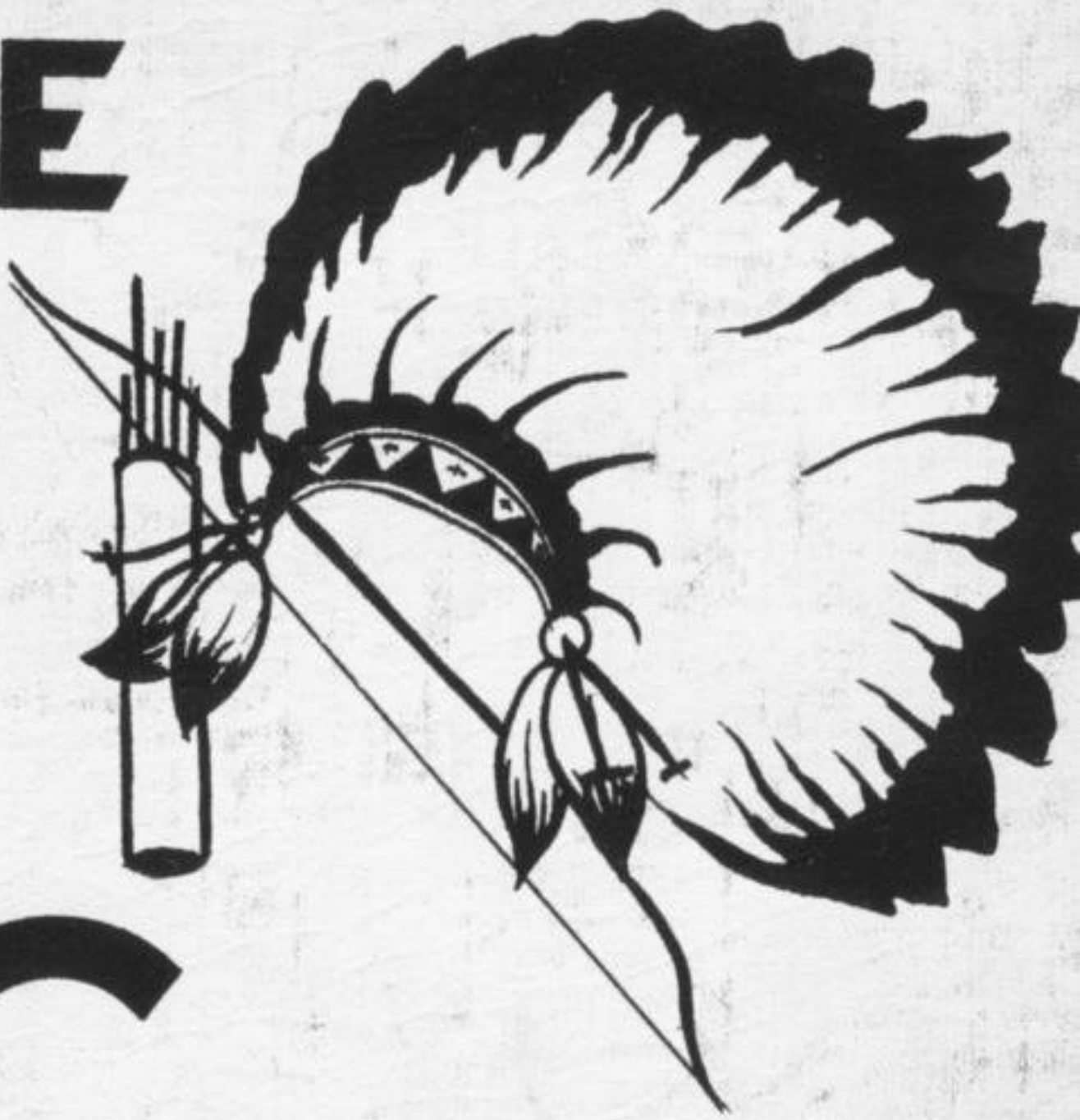

Foreword



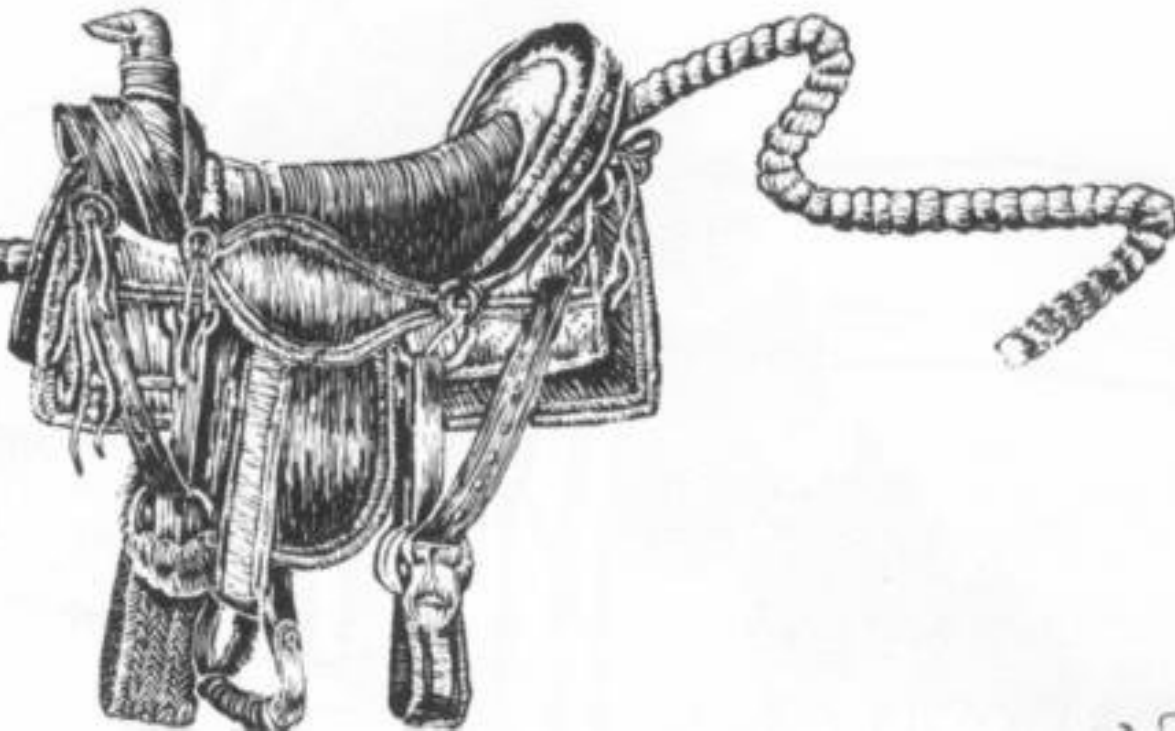
Because we believe introductions enhance appreciation, we would like to introduce the 1959 Echo to you.

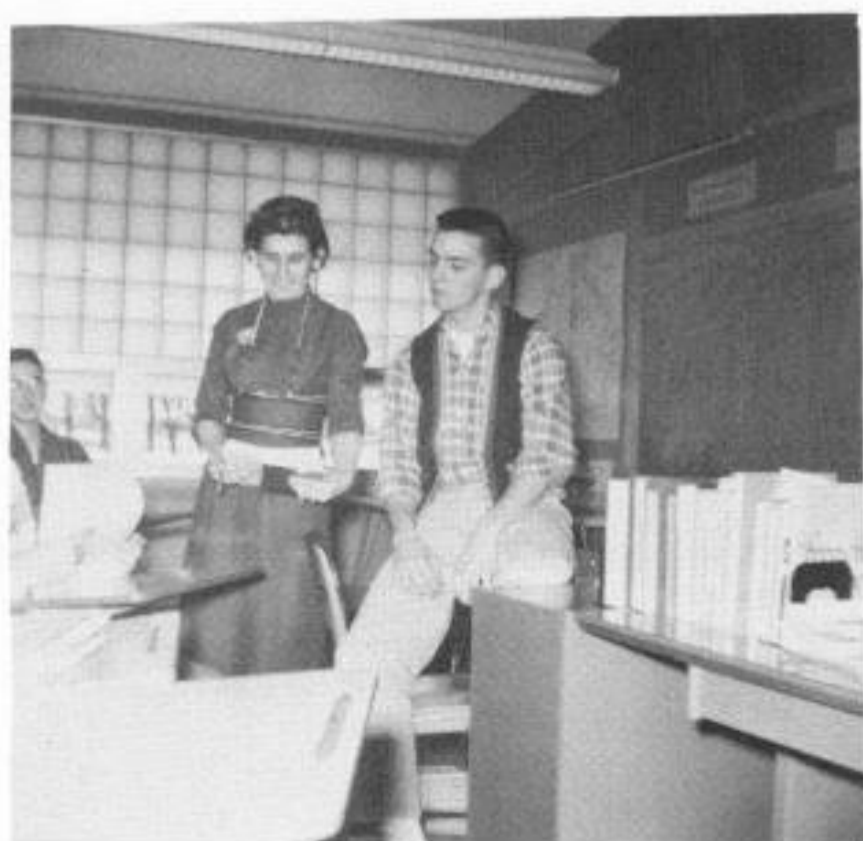

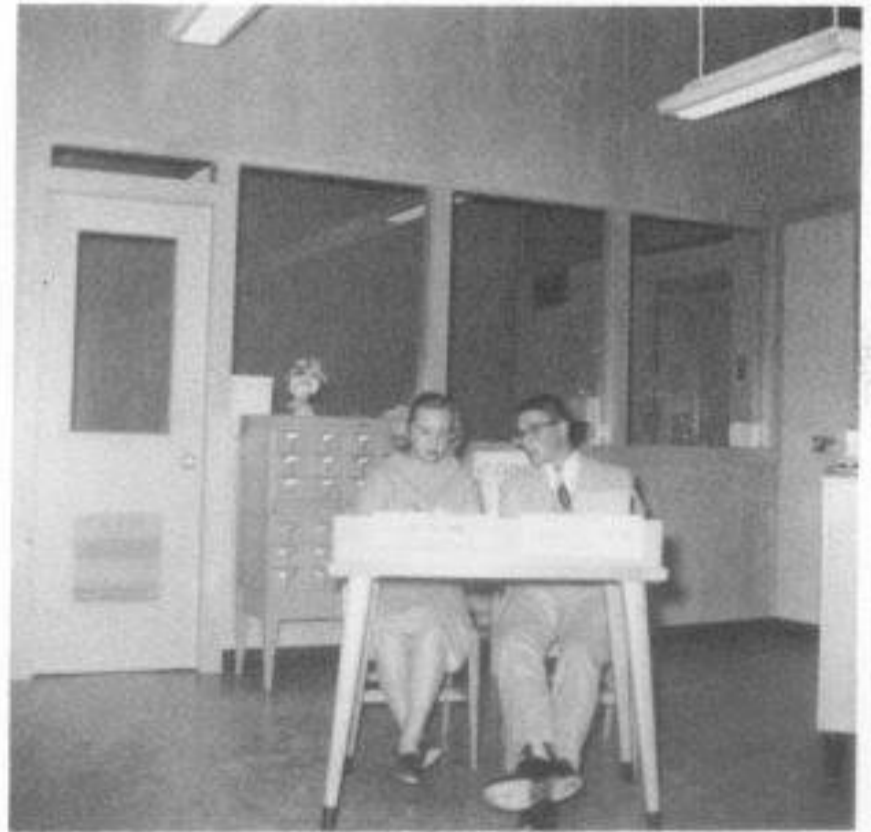

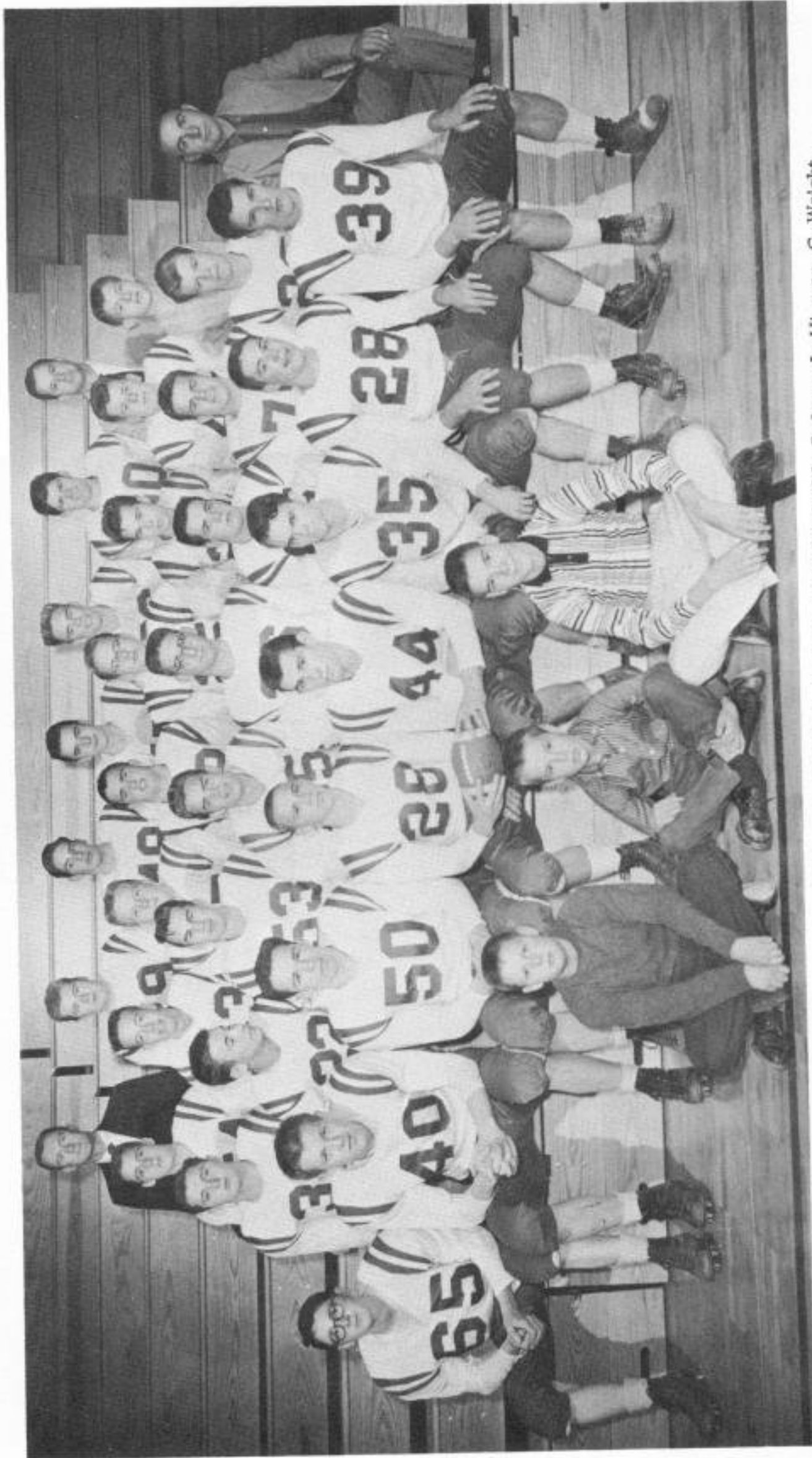

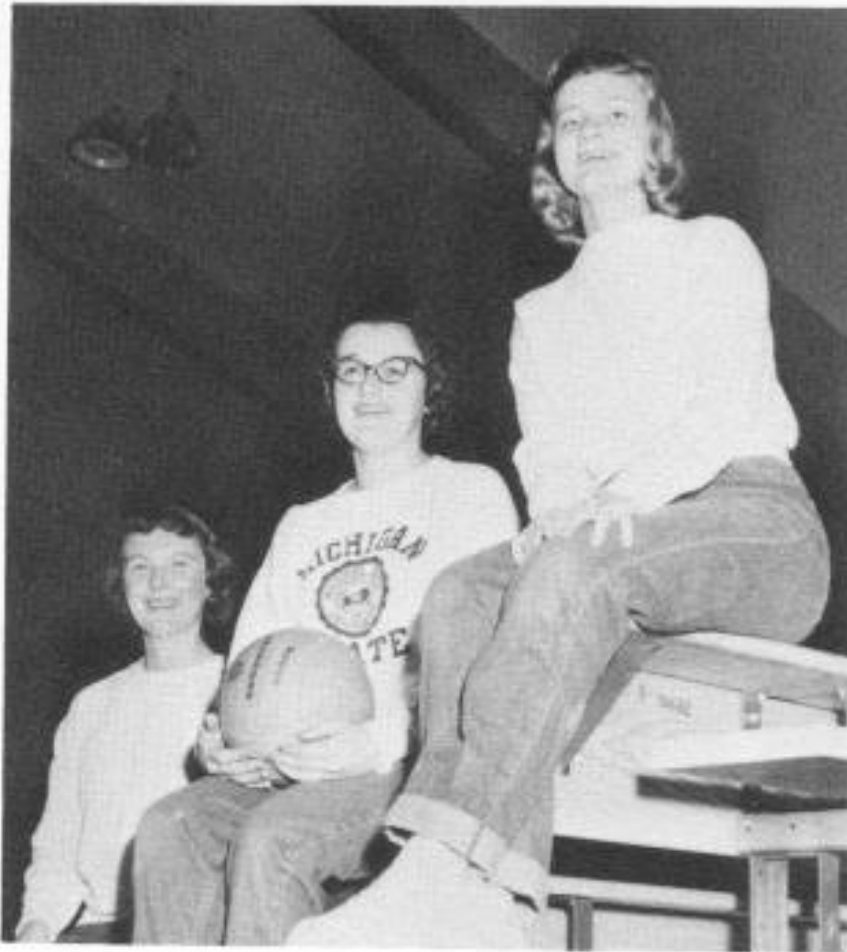
