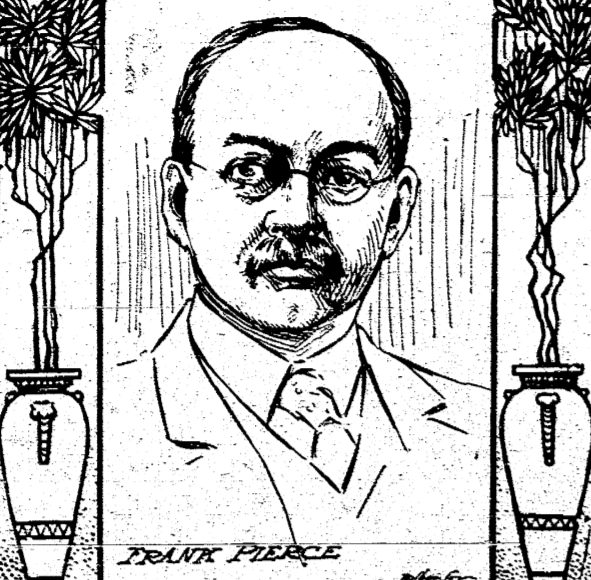

SEVERELY CROSS-EXAMINED BY CLARENCE DARROW FOR DEFENSE.
