USA Varsity Basketball team ready to 'wait & see'

Veteran USA boys basketball coach John Manninen expects to have a "wait and see" outlook when it comes to predicting how his team's 1995-96 basketball season will pan out.

"I think we will be 'spurdy' until we gain experience and confidence," Manninen says.

His reasoning comes from the loss of the entire starting lineup from last year's district champs who ended up in a solid second place behind the Reese Rockets.

USA finished the season with a 14-9 record, but was strong in the league with a 10-2 mark.

Even though the USA's roster lists six seniors this time around, Manninen cites only returning lettermen Bob Arnold and Shaun Gremel with any valuable back-up experience from last year's squad.

However, before you count USA out of any title race, one must look at the strong nucleus of six juniors moving up from an excellent JV program which ended the season with a 17-3 mark.

Senior Bob Arnold (6'6") will service notice to area rebounders, and will be amply assisted by senior Scott Jahr (6'3") and juniors Eric Kelly (6'3") and Shaun Gainforth (6'3").

Senior Shaun Gremel and junior Dan Sweetman will add speed and outside shooting from the guard positions.

Although Manninen sees his team as very inexperienced and mostly untested, those familiar with his coaching style and the USA basketball program in general should not take his team lightly.

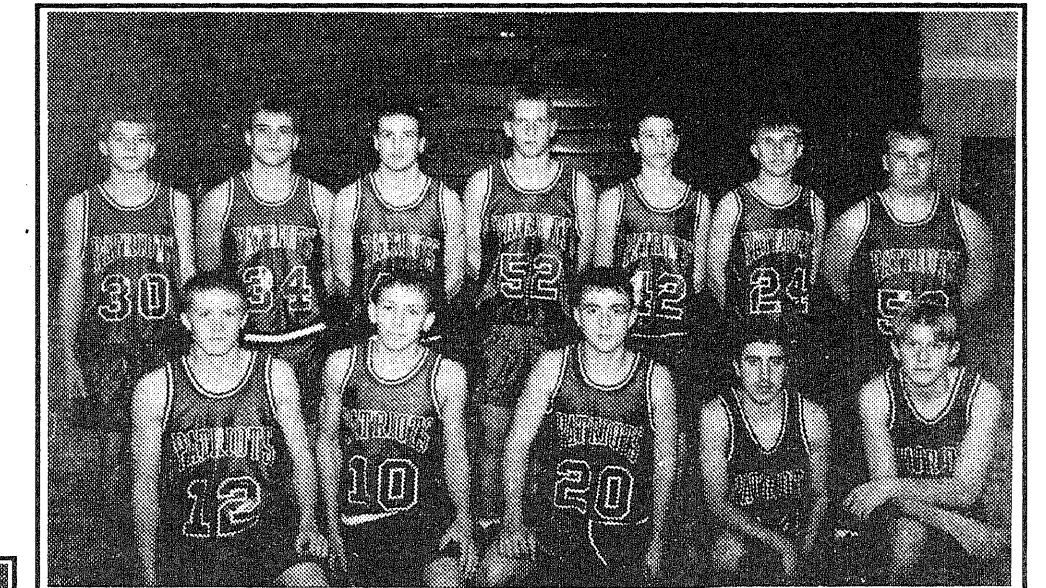

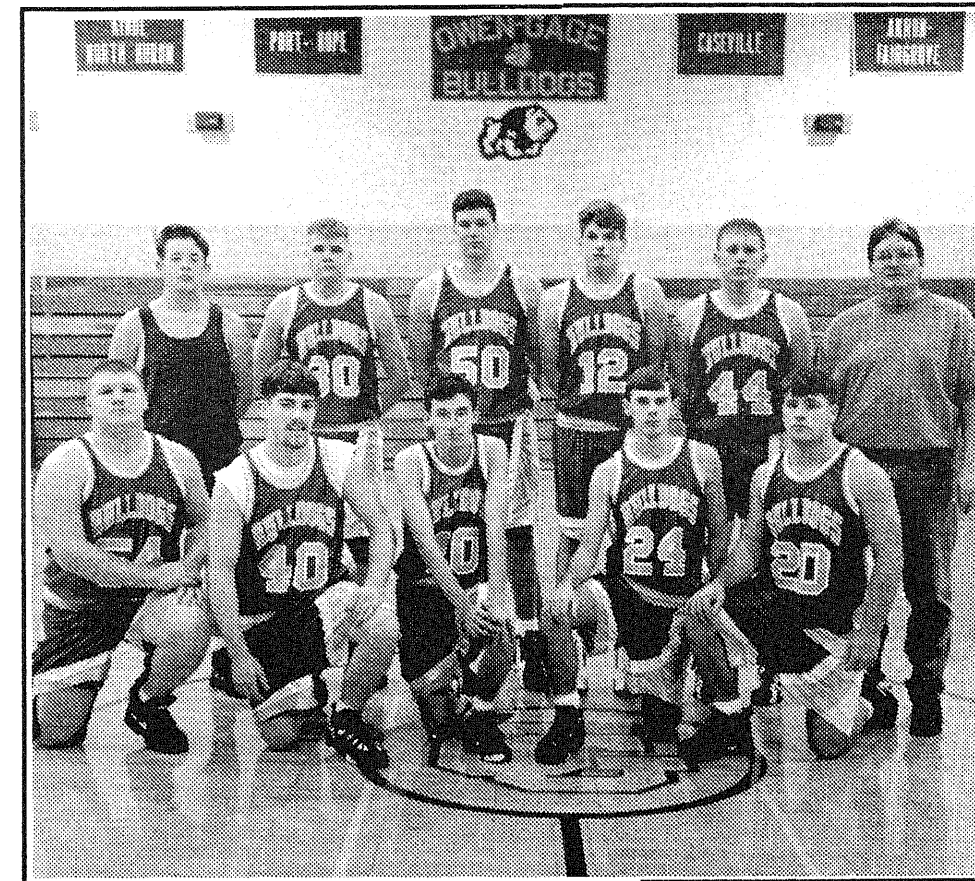

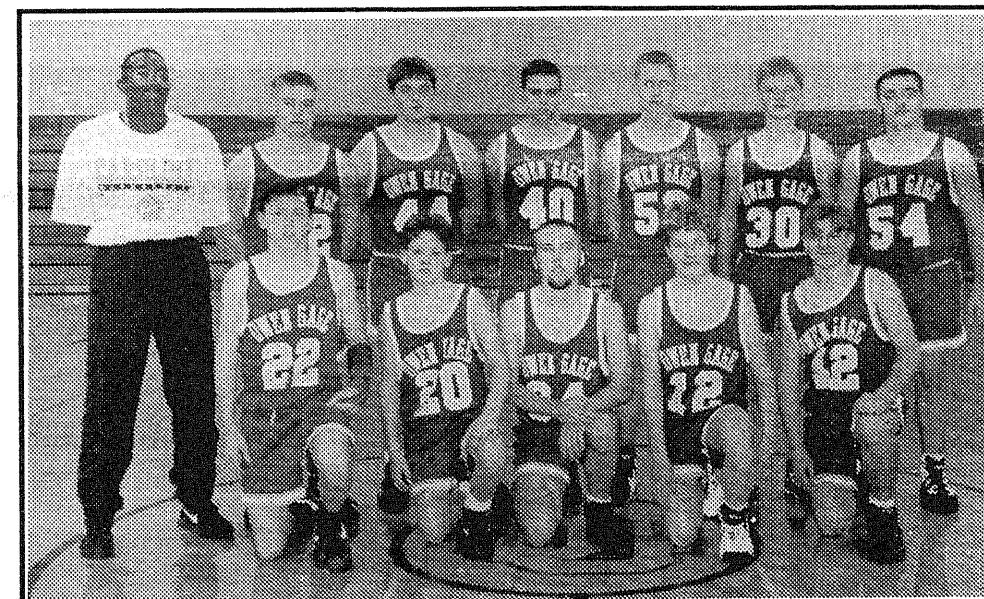

Owen-Gage Varsity Basketball team has senior experience

The Owen-Gage Bulldogs field a team this year strong in experience, loaded with seniors. 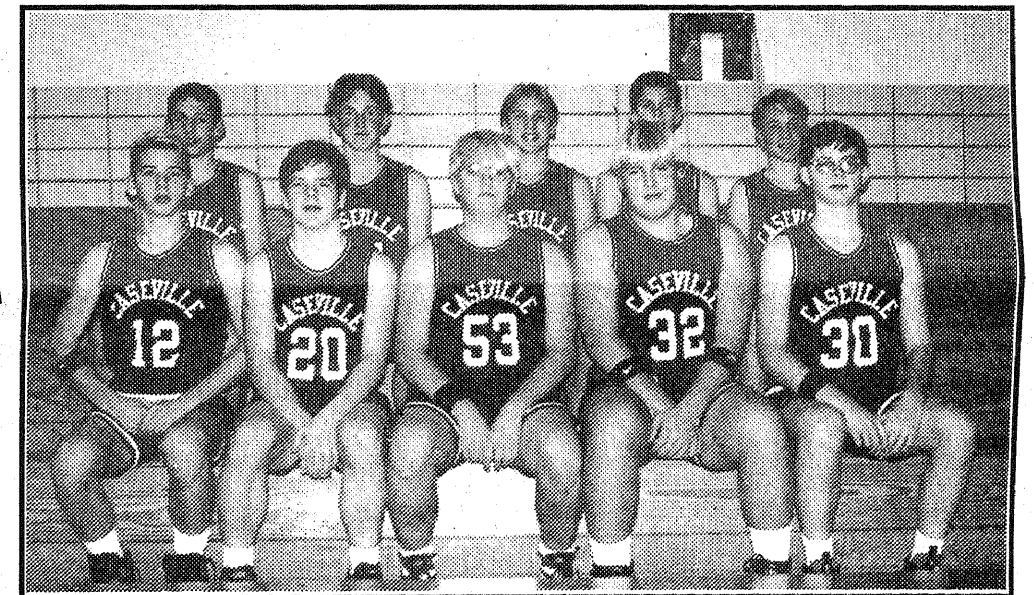
Hatfield noted that the Eagles should be strong in their outside play, but need to work on their three-point long-range shooting.

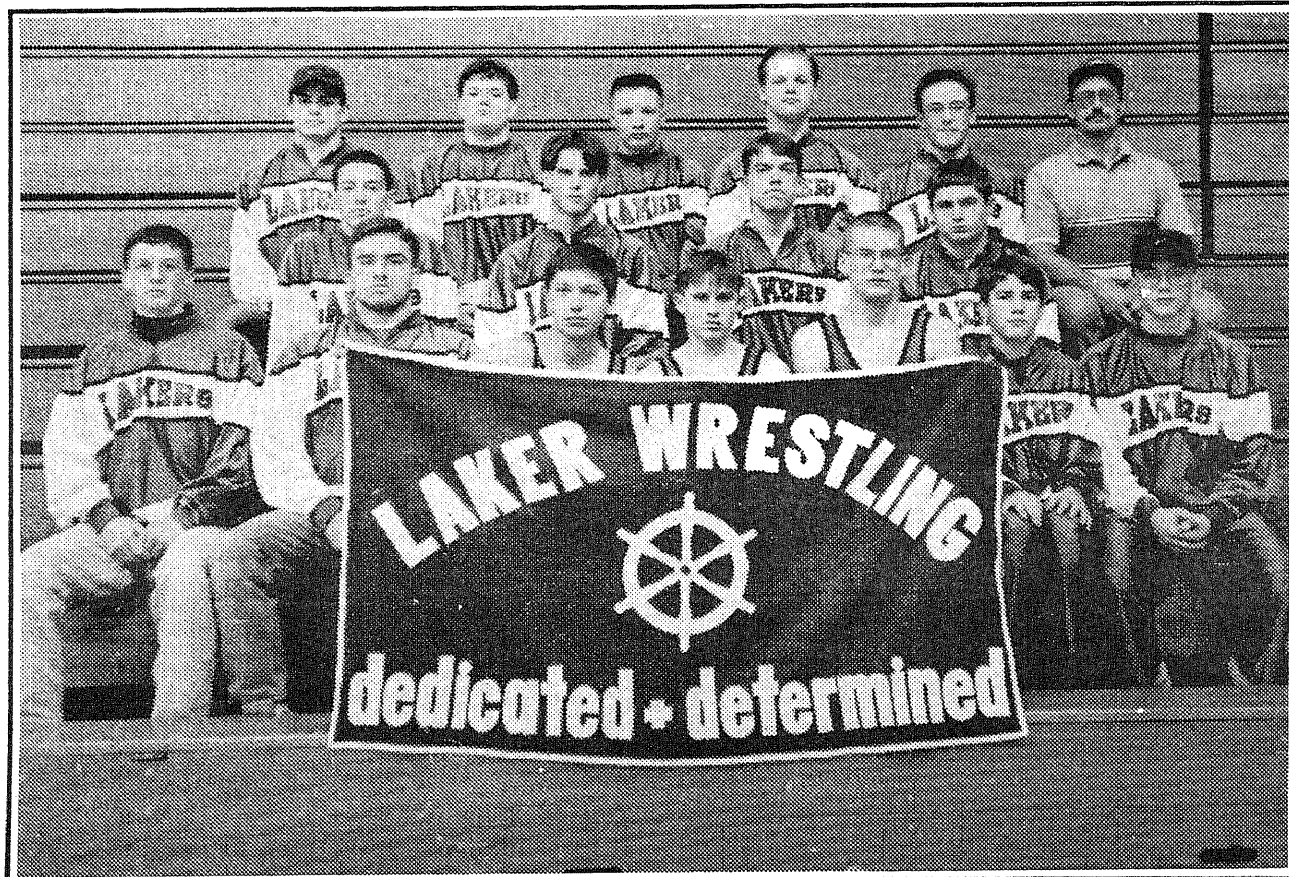

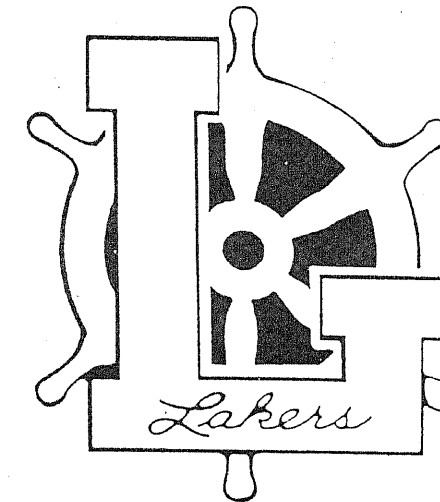
