By this system convicts sentenced to terms of imprisonment are released conditionally, and furnished with papers certifying the fact, which they are to withdraw for bad conduct, and then the criminal then goes back to prison. The original idea seems to have been that these papers were never to be granted except in cases where there were signs of amendment. But in practice little attention has been paid to this. A swarm of prisoners has been turned loose, many of whom are still bent on taking their lives and the lives of others. This tickle-flick system was introduced to clear the crowded prison after the practice of transportation for crimes had been discontinued.
