THE TWO-THIRDS VOTE.

History of the Rule Making a Two-Thirds

Vote Necessary to Amend the National Con-

stitution in Democratic National Conven-

tion.

From the Boston Post.

As the convention at Cincinnati will be

called on to take action on this subject, a

brief history of the two-thirds rule may be

of some interest. It was first adopted in

1832 at the convention in Baltimore held

in connection with the election of Vice Pres-

ident. Gen. Jackson had already been put

in nomination for President, not by a Na-

tional convention, but by the Democratic

convention in Baltimore. With respect to

the sentiment of the party was con-

deemed necessary. But there were three dis-

SENATE.

The Senate passed the Pension Deficiency

appropriation bill, amounting to \$240,000.

A bill passed providing that section 3 of

the act increasing the position of widows

and orphans, approved July 25, 1866, and

section 13 of the pension act of July 27,

1868, and section 4712 revised statute,

shall not operate to reduce the rate of pen-

sions which have been allowed to naval

officers and their widows, etc., prior to July

20, 1866, and that such pensions shall be

reduced to the rate from which they were

reduced, to date from the original date of

such pensions.

Senator Morgan's joint resolution pro-

viding a rule for counting the electoral

vote was passed, after a long debate, by a

party vote, Yeas 25, Nays 14.

A bill passed extending the northern

boundary of Nebraska to the Canadian

territory of Dakota south of the

43d parallel east of Keopala river, and

west of the main channel of the Missouri

river when the Indian title will be extin-

guished.

The Agricultural appropriation bill was

passed. It adds about \$2,000 to the bill

passed from the House. The amendments

provide \$15,000 for the purchase of im-

achinery and apparatus, and for experi-

ments in manufacturing sugar from sorghum

and corn stalks, and other sugar-growing

plants, also \$8,000 for experiments in con-

nection with the culture and manufacture

Hints for June Work.

Swedish Turnips may be sown this
month, in drills 20 inches apart. A
plenty of seed should be sown, to in-
sure an even stand of plants.—2 lbs.
per acre is not too much. The land
should be well manured, and thor-
oughly prepared—a fine tilth is es-
pecially essential to success on old
ground. Thin the plants, when the
second leaf appears, to at least 12
inches apart. Partial or total fail-
ure, in many cases, to be attributed
to defective thinning.
Haying.—Clover and Timothy
should be cut when in full blossom;
if allowed to get ripe, the quality of
hay is not so good. By beginning
early the work need not be hurried.
Use the mower after the dew is off in
the forenoon. Cut only as much as
can be well cared for. It is often re-
marked that the average quality of
hay is not so good as before the in-
roduction of the mowing machines,
from the temptation to cut the grass
faster than it can be cured.
Sheep Shearing.—Washing sheep
under the present system of buying
wool, will perhaps be the prevailing
practice. If care is taken to keep
the sheep so that the wool will not
be filled with dirt, it is better not
to wash. Fleeces should be done up
with care, nicely rolled and securely
tied with light twine. When it is
known that a farmer puts up his wool
in neat shape without any tags, etc.,
he will obtain the highest price.
Everywhere, but especially here,
"honesty is the best policy."
Ticks.—Immediately after shearing,
the ticks leave the sheep for the long-
wool of the lambs. The lambs thus
infested should be dipped in a de-
coction of tobacco stems, which
will destroy the ticks. Several special
dips are in the market.
Buckwheat may be sown during this
month, and may be made a profit-
able crop, especially upon newly
cleared ground where the mellowing
of the soil and the richness of the
Silver-Hull buckwheat is better
than the common variety, the yield
being greater, and the flour from it is
whiter and of a finer quality than the
ordinary sort.

GARDEN AND NURSERY.
Orchards.—With newly planted
trees it will pay to give white time
in examining their condition. If they
are loose or leaning to one side, a
minute spent in pressing the soil
about them with the foot will often
save them. A mulching, if not al-
ready given to the young trees, should
be provided before the long drouth.
Almost any substance that will cover
the soil and protect it from the sun
will do.

Grafts set this spring should be
looked to, and if the bud or buds
grow too vigorously, pinch back into
shape; in fact a graft should be treated
as if it were a young tree. Cut
away all shoots that come upon the
stock below the graft, and the growth
will be of the branches of the graft
interfered with by surrounding
branches.

Pruning.—June is a good time for
pruning. Larger limbs may be cut
away now, covering all cuts with var-
nish, paint, or melted grafting wax.
Thinning Fruit.—The sooner this
essential to the production of the best
fruit is done the better. It is seldom
overdone, and too frequently entirely
neglected. Thinning increases the
size and improves the quality of the
fruit, and with young trees, just start-
ing into bearing, it is a necessity.

KITCHEN AND MARKET GARDEN.
This is the time when the rake and
hoe count for so much in the suc-
cess of the season's work. The weeds
must be kept down, or much of the
labor of preparation and planting is
lost. It is observed that the rake is
put before the hoe, and it should be
so in the garden. A frequent use of
a long and sharp-toothed steel rake
will save much hard hoeing, and at
the same time keep the soil in a bet-
ter condition for the young growing
plants.
