...the mill... Mr. Hamilton... Mr. Hamilton, one of the proprietors of the mill, says the frame of the mill is worth \$15,000, though it may reach \$20,000. It is his opinion that the battery of four boilers exploded and tore the mill into pieces. The brick boiler house, 40x80 feet, was completely leveled, and the brick smokestack, 125 feet high, nine of the boilers were 22 feet long and 42 inch shell, and 14 feet long. All were in good condition. The mill has cut 22,000,000 feet of lumber this season, and would have shut down in a week. The explosion is supposed to have been caused by low water, but as all those about the premises at the time are dead this cannot be verified.

GENERAL NEWS.
Secretary Folger assumed charge of the Treasury Department Monday morning. He accepted the position of Attorney General MacVeagh, and the Department will remain in charge of Solicitor General Phillips until a new appointment is made. It is reported that George C. Gorham will be tendered the Assistant Secretaryship of the Treasury, and that Senator Mahone will be offered a seat in the cabinet. Mr. Folger, after declining the Attorney Generalship, has accepted the Secretaryship of State. At Marion Station, Va., a band of five men opened fire on the whites at the polls, by which four white men were killed and two seriously wounded. A. T. Harvey, Democratic candidate for Governor, was slain. Two armed squads went to the scene of the trouble from Meridian and found 100 negroes barricaded in the houses. A. T. Harvey was killed in which John Vance, a colored man, and A. G. Warren, of the Sheriff's posse, were killed, about thirty negroes escaped to the woods under a doctor. Guiteau was taken from the jail in Washington to the court-room by the prison van and an escort of halibut, an hour before the commencement of the trial. Contrary to frequent predictions, District Attorney Calkins appeared as prosecutor. Mr. Robinson asked for more time for the defense, whereupon Guiteau rose and declared that he was ready to try the case now. Mr. Scoville was very indignant over the proceedings, but was pacified by Judge Jones. A jury was obtained from the panel, and an order was entered to draw seventy-five additional names from the box. Guiteau gave a roll of names to a reporter, but Mr. Scoville forced its return. In passing out of the court-room Guiteau clung to the officers as if from a sickle.
