Public Notice is hereby given that on the 3rd day of July, A. D. 1882, at ten o'clock in the forenoon, at the house of R. C. DeLong, in the township of Owosso, in the county of Shiawassee, I will be present for the purpose of letting contracts for the construction of a drain in said township, described as follows: Commencing at a point 4 chains west and 2.50-100th chains south of the northeast corner of the south-west 1/4 of section nine, in the township of Owosso, thence running south 88° 21' east, 12.50-100th chains, thence north 73° 20' west, 2.50-100th chains, thence north 50° east 4.97-100th chains, thence north 10° east 1.50-100th chains, thence north parallel with said line 24.52-100th chains, thence north 80° west 1.75-100th chains, thence north 18° west 2.45-100th chains, and so continuing until it intersects a drain constructed by Thomas Mathias on the south-east 1/4 of section 5, said drain 16 ft. 6 in. wide and 2 feet deep on an average, and known as the DeLong drain, and that at that time I will let contracts for the construction of said drain by section to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders. Also take notice that I will then and there, at the time of the letting of such contracts, be present to receive all assessment of benefits upon the lands from which said drain is to be constructed, and assessed for the construction thereof.

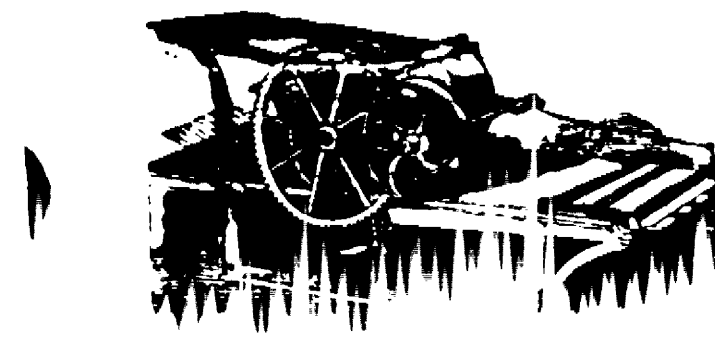


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### Testimony in the

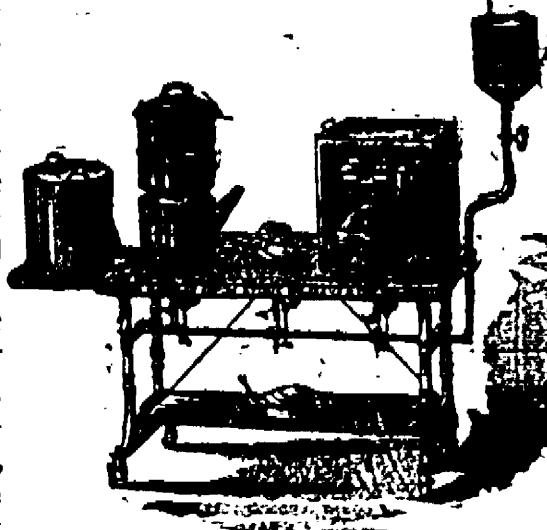

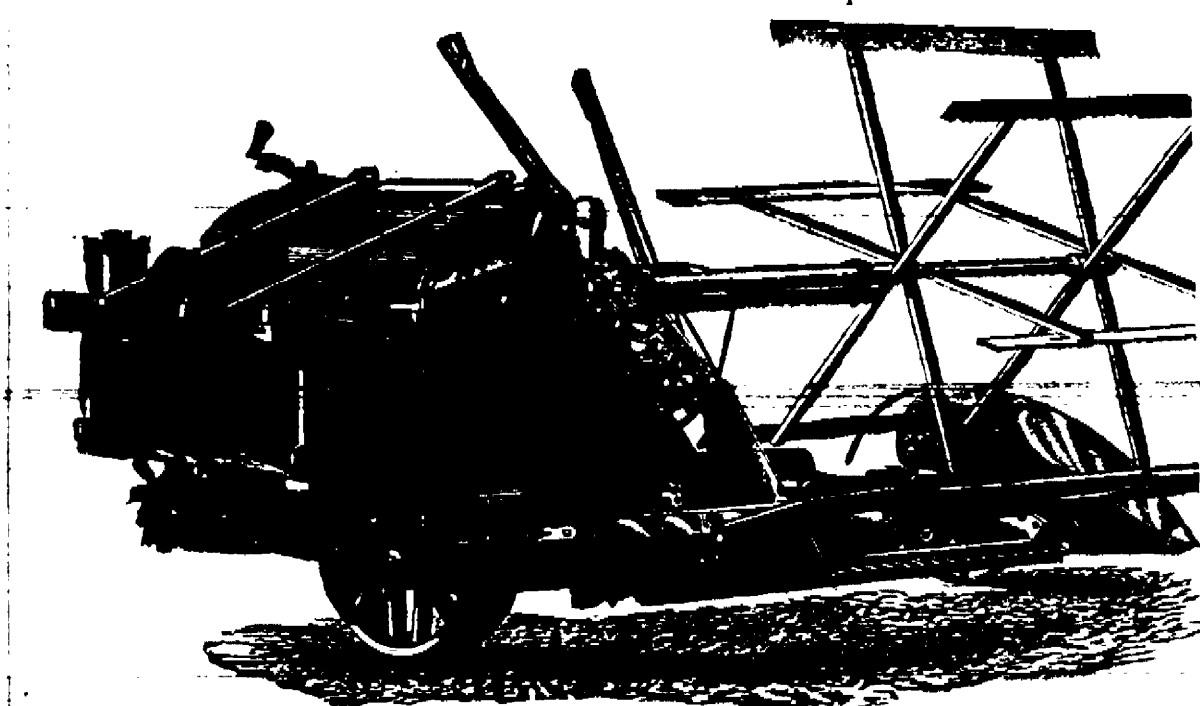
