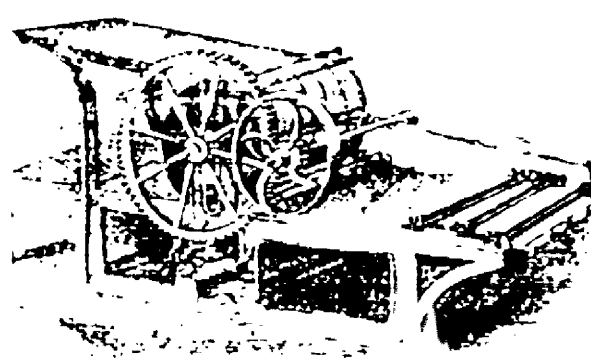

The board of arbitration agreed upon between the Union Pacific Railroad Company and the engineers rendered a decision in favor of the engineers.

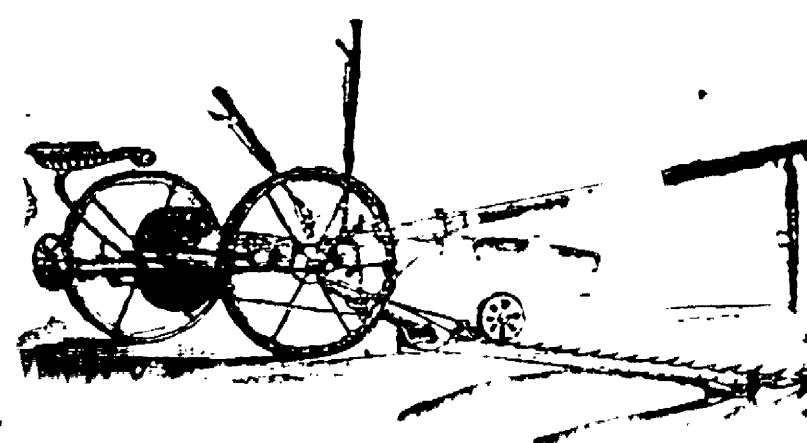
Captain Murrell, of the steamship Missouri, has had conferred on him, by order of the King of Denmark, the knighthood of the Order of Dannebrog.

After making a dramatic speech to the Indians at Rhineville, American Horse signed the Sioux reservation contract. Little Wound made a speech in opposition.

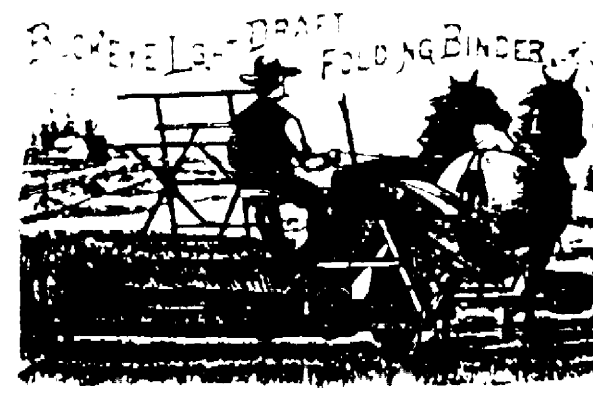
Frederick T. Prentice, the New York millionaire, has been awarded the possession of 120 acres in the center of Duluth on an old title. The property is worth \$5,000,000.

MOWER.**

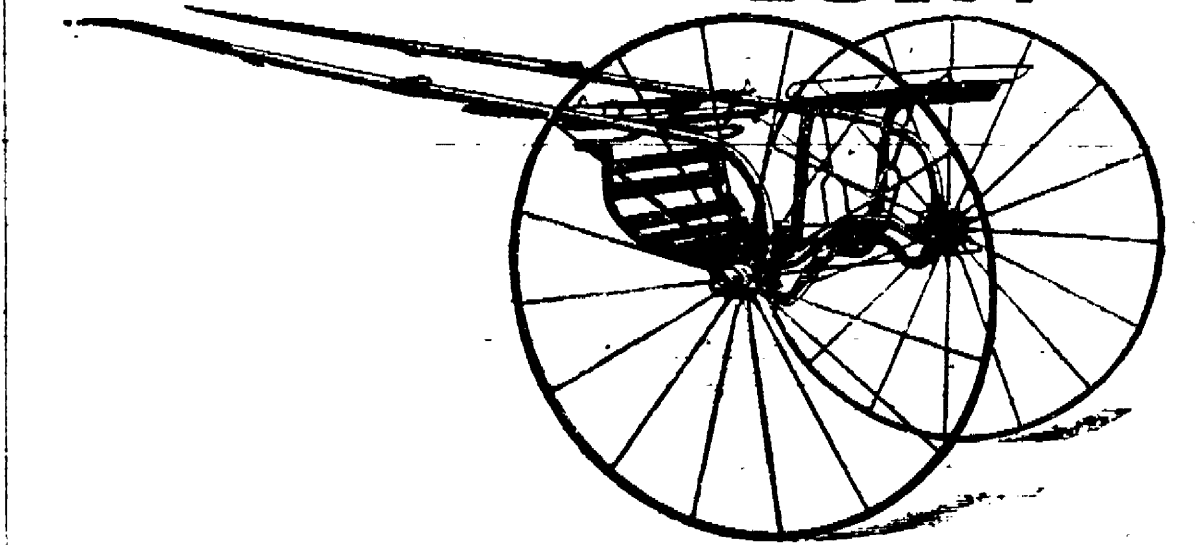
