# **Greg Hennessy Profile**

Ever since he was a kid working on the grounds crew at Nashawtuc Country Club in Concord, Mass., Greg Hennessy knew in his heart that he would someday make a living in the field of agronomy. And while the road has been full of unexpected twists and turns, the 58-year-old has indeed enjoyed a flourishing career in the field he loves so much, even if his business card doesn't say "superintendent" on it.

"I've been blessed," he says convincingly. "I've worked in the same industry for 40 years and still really enjoy going to work every day. That's not something many people can say. But that's how I feel and that's what keeps me going."

You can sure that there are countless superintendents across the region who are quite pleased that Hennessy is still punching the clock each day. Hennessy is a golf service technician for BISCO, the exclusive Rain Bird golf distributor in New England. He and his team are counted on heavily by courses that run into emergency situations and have earned the reputation as life savers in the most critical moments.

"It helps that all of us at BISCO are familiar with the superintendent industry because we know what these guys are up against on a daily basis and the kind of pressures they face," said Hennessy. "They're all under the same microscope and they rely on us to come through when they need us most and usually we're successful.

"We're not 100 percent, but we're pretty close. It's a commitment we make to these guys when they buy a system of this magnitude. We have to show a commitment in return. We don't look at them as customers or clients. We look at each course as a partner of ours and that's why we're so sympathetic to their needs when a problem arises."

Of course that means a lot of urgent situations at inconvenient times. Late nights. Early mornings. Holiday weekends. It doesn't matter when the call comes in from one of the nearly 500 courses BISCO services, Hennessy and his team react as quickly as possible.

"If it's urgent, we'll be there within 24 hours," he explains proudly. "We have to figure out which course is worse off and help them first. Not to sound too dramatic, but it's almost like doing triage in an emergency room. These guys count

on us and we don't like to disappoint. At the same time they are patient with me and know that some one else may be in a more dire need."

Hennessy realizes what it's like to have these kinds of situations because he's worked on a golf course nearly his entire life. After catching the "superintendent bug" at Nashawtuc as a youngster, Hennessy went to Stockbridge School at the University of Massachusetts Amherst, where he graduated in 1976. He returned to Nashawtuc as

a foreman but then moved on to work as a landscape contractor and quickly realized it wasn't for him.

"I missed the golf industry and wanted to get back into it," he remembers. "Even if it wasn't on a grounds crew or as a super, I needed to get back to where I belonged."

He had a friend that worked as a Rainbird distributor and helped get him on board in sales. He learned more about the irrigation business and eventually began working as a consultant before finally finding his niche with BISCO eight years ago.

Hennessy says that part of the reason he loves his job so much is because he gets to deal with superintendents every day.

"They're a special breed," he says. "In 40-plus years in the business I don't think I've met one person I don't like. They're all very dedicated people who are happy to be doing what they're doing. They'll do anything to help a colleague. And they're all great guys. That's why we try so hard to make



their lives easier. We know they would do the same for someone else in need."

Hennessy is also aided by the fact that he has outlets outside of work and is fortunate enough to have a solid family support system. The 16-handicap plays in a Friday night league at The Overlook Golf Club in Hollis, NH and makes an annual golf trip with his buddies to Myrtle Beach in January.

He and his wife like to travel as well and they keep busy by keeping tabs on their three children. His son Patrick is leaning toward following his father's footsteps by interning at Brae Burn Country Club in West Newton, Mass. after spending four years in the Marines.

"Maybe he sees how happy I am at nearly 60 years old and wants to try duplicate that kind of life," Hennessy says with a laugh. "There's certainly something about working outside every day and being with people you genuinely like. I love the fact that we get the chance to help someone out and eliminate one of their headaches. That's what keeps me ticking and I have no plans to slow down. I'm having too much fun." •



these knowledgeable volunteers go about the process of rating the multiple factors that contribute to the evaluation and final result of the process. Scott explained in detail how the raters come to the conclusions that result in the course rating. I learned the process is about as objective as an undertaking like this can be. Something that stood out was that it takes interested people willing to devote their time and energy to be course raters and help make the game more enjoyable for all of us.

Last month I attended a meeting of the New England Interstate Water Pollution Control Commission in Boston. What this commission is trying to do is develop voluntary formulation and usage guidelines for phosphorous and nitrogen in fertilizers and the application of both to prevent pollution of water bodies. Meetings have been held with synthetic and organic producers of fertilizers to gather their input. Later this year representatives of end users – golf course superintendents, sports turf managers and others will be invited to attend a meeting so their input can be considered for inclusion in the commission's deliberations.

What the commission is trying to do is keep phosphorous and nitrogen out of bodies of water, while at the same time allow reasonable usage of fertilizer containing phosphorous and nitrogen. Our interests will be represented at these meetings and you'll be kept apprised of the commission's actions. If you'd like more information on this please get in touch with me.
