# MICHIGAN STATE COLLEGE

S THE OLDEST land grant college in the United States and the oldest agricultural college in the world, Michigan State College provides a technical, practical, and cultural education for its student body, in addition to extensive research and extension services to the people of Michigan.

Now in its 93rd year, Michigan State College has grown from one building and four faculty members to one of the largest universities in the nation. It has approximately 1,400 staff members, 150 modern permanent and 988 temporary buildings, and almost 12,000 acres of land.

In 1855, the course of study at Michigan State College consisted largely of learning the fundamentals of farming by cultivating the college grounds. Today, more than 50 different courses of study are offered in the Schools of Agriculture, Business and Public Service, Engineering, Home Economics, Science and Arts, and Veterinary Medicine. This excludes the curriculum of the Basic College which has been hailed as one of the most progressive ideas for higher education in the nation today; and the Graduate School, which offers courses leading to the degrees of master of arts, master of science, master of music, master of forestry, doctor of philosophy, and doctor of education.

Michigan State College continually strives to expand its service to the people of the state. Five sub-stations of the Agricultural Experiment Station are maintained in various parts of the state, and more than 60 conferences, short courses and special courses are held each year on the Spartan campus. During the 1947-48 year, more than 40,000 persons attended these "extra-curricular" educational courses and meetings.

Today, some 15,000 students from Michigan and other states and from nations all over the world are attending the college at East Lansing—11,000 of whom are housed on the campus proper. With about 85 per cent of these students coming from communities in every section of the state, Michigan State College is doing its part to fill the greatly increased demand of the younger generation for higher education.

In the agricultural, business and professional fields, Michigan State College has proved its worth to the people of the state of Michigan, paying dividends many times the appropriation for its maintenance made each year by the state and national governments. Noted for its democratic and friendly spirit, the student body harmonizes with the college faculty to make Michigan State College a first class educational institution.

## VISITORS ARE WELCOME

## COLLEGE MUSEUM-

The College Museum, downstairs from main lobby of the College auditorium, will be open to visitors this afternoon from 1:00 to 5:00. Attention of the public is called especially to the new exhibit of Michigan deer in their natural surroundings; exhibit of Michigan birds with dates of arrival; the old Bolivian mummy; a panorama of the glacial evolution of Michigan; and "Weapons of War" from the crossbow of 1500 A. D. to the "bazooka" and "grease gun" of World War II.

## THE MUSIC ART GALLERY-

An exhibition of work by students in the Department of Art is on display in the Art Gallery in the basement of the Music building. The examples constitute a selection of the best work done during the past year in ceramics, clay modeling, drawing, painting, design and print making. Visitors are cordially welcomed. There is no charge.

## WKAR, COLLEGE RADIO STATION-

WKAR, the 5,000 watt College Radio Station, with studios above the main entrance to the auditorium, is open all day to visitors.

### BEAL BOTANICAL GARDENS-

In the Beal Botanical Gardens are between two and three thousand botanical plants. The Gardens are open to visitors any time.

## THE FREDERICK COWLES JENISON GYMNASIUM AND FIELDHOUSE—

The Frederick Cowles Jenison Gymnasium and Fieldhouse, one of the largest and best equipped buildings for physical education and athletics in the nation, is the scene of the ninetieth annual commencement. It houses the Department of Physical Education for men and provides facilities for all collegiate sports. The building will be open all day to visitors.

#### HORTICULTURAL GARDENS—

The Horticultural Gardens, east of the Horticulture Building and the greenhouses, will be open all day to visitors.

## THE COLLEGE FARMS-

The College Farms are located on the south side of the Red Cedar River. By driving south on Farm Lane, the road running north and south past the College Auditorium, many of the farm buildings can be seen. Attention of the visitors is called especially to the College Dairy Barn, the Beef Cattle Barn, the Pavilion, the new Agricultural Engineering Building, and the Forestry Nursery.

## MICHIGAN STATE COLLEGE BUILDING PROGRAM—

An extensive building program, about two-thirds of which is to be completed this year, can be viewed by a drive over the campus. Names and locations of buildings recently completed or under construction are: Landon, Yakeley and Gilchrist Halls for women, northwest campus; Mason-Abbot and Snyder-Phillips Halls for men, east campus; science building, east of M.S.C. dairy building; Berkey Hall, classroom building, and home management building, along Grand River avenue; power plant and foods storage buildings, both east of stadium; electrical engineering building, northwest of bandshell; physics and mathematics building, east of anatomy building; agricultural engineering building, on Farm Lane south of the river; additions to the Union Memorial building and Macklin Field stadium; 11 brick apartment buildings and temporary housing for faculty and students, southwest of Jenison fieldhouse.
