Sub Surface Watering. Bob Main, owner of Loch Lomond G. C. in Flint has installed a new style watering system in two greens and a tee. One half inch perferated plastic pipe was buried nine inches below the surface of the green in a grid system with the lines 30 inches apart, extending completely across the green and apron area. A pressure control valve to keep between one and two pounds of pressure on the lines was installed. A ball check valve was also installed so the lines would drain themselves when the system was turned off. A more complete description of the installation can be obtained from Bob Main. Imagine watering the greens while the golfers are putting!
