MICHIGAN State once had a beautiful cam-M pas. The school on the banks of the Red Cedar was famed throughout the midwest for its clean walks, well groomed lawns, and beautiful trees.

Today, the 92 year old nosmoking on campus tradition, which always has been enforced by the students themselves, is all but buried six feet under the campus. fronically, the death blow came from the very administration which long has encouraged the enforcement of this tradi-

tion.

The killing blow is in the form of the no smoking in campus buildings rule which for-bids the lighted weed in any building except the Union or designated areas of dormitor ies. The entercement of this old rule is a sound safety measure. Few MSC buildings can be considered 100 per cent fire proof.


