

THINCLADS SPLASH WAY TO 86-45 VICTORY OVER MUNIES

Score Slams in Six Events to Overcome City College.

State easily overcame the way in a steady shower of points in 45 minutes, downing the City College dual track and field team Saturday afternoon. The victory was a decisive one, with the Spartans winning six of the seven events and losing only the 400-yard dash. The Spartans' lead was established in the 100-yard dash, where Lewis, the star of the team, won in 15.4 seconds. He then continued his winning streak by taking the 200-yard dash in 32.2 seconds, the 400-yard dash in 1:02.2, the 800-yard dash in 2:22.7, the 1,600-yard dash in 5:16.5, the 3,200-yard dash in 11:45.5, and the 6,400-yard dash in 24:15.5. The Spartans' lead was further solidified in the 12.5-mile run, where they won by 10 minutes and 15 seconds.
