

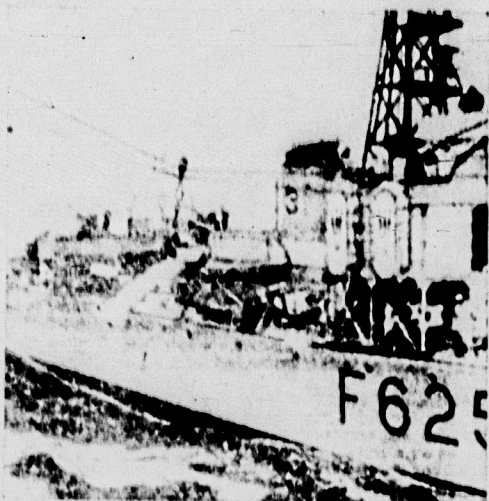
Pope Forbids Catholics To Vote for Communists

Decree Has World Wide Significance

VATICAN CITY, April 14.—Pope Pius XII has issued a decree declaring that Catholics are forbidden to vote for Communist candidates in any election, national or local, in which the Communist Party is a candidate.

The decree, made public today, is the first of its kind since the Second World War.

The pope said that Catholics should not vote for Communist candidates because they are "materialist and atheistic."

Professor Leads All Candidates

Professor Gordon Thomas of the MSU speech dept. waded into local politics last Monday, leading all six of the candidates in votes at the East Lansing polls for seats on the city council.

Recording 1,641 votes, the Marine district being held in an impressive last Wednesday, that he will be a lifetime for a year in the council meetings. Thomas stated that because this is his first venture into politics of this nature, he will be content to learn.

Thomas added however that East Lansing must look to the future in areas of water and sewage problems concerning the newly annexed districts and he feels that there should be progress made in providing these services to all parts of the city.

Thomas, who has been a member of the council since 1957, will be re-elected to the council office at Monday night's council meeting, where three incumbents elected, including Mayor Peter Meyer, will be succeeded by Max Stricker and Arthur Powers among others.

The council also elected to reappoint John Patterson as city manager and Raymond Campbell as city auditor. All other business was either carried over or referred to the planning commission for further action.

Although Thomas has been a leader in the Marine area and has been with the council since 1949, he stated that he expects to represent the city as a whole.

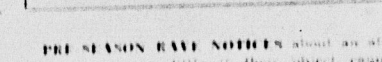
