WASHINGTON (P)-A New Jersey firm which prints Sunday newspaper supplements has paid a convicted labor extertionist and his relatives nearly \$260,000 to shield it from labor troubles, Senate investigators were told Wed-

Executives of the Nos Grav-ness Printing Co., Weehawken, NJ, testified \$131,439.95 went to Harold Gross over the past 14 years, since his release from prison. On top of that, they said, they have paid a total of \$128,-376.95 to certain of Gross' rela-

The company officials said they were forced to put these relatives on the payroll along with Gross, now a Teamster Union official in Miami but still drawing payments from Neo Gravine Charles Chenleck, vice president of the firm, said Gross does no actual work for Neo
