13 Americans Play On Freshman Team

Canadian students weren't allowed to enroll at MSU as six Michiganers and two men from Massachusetts had chosen to "pursue their academic interests" at coach Amo Besone's freshman hockey team might as well be the case, since five of those players come from Canada and another of the 13 men is a son of the Michigan and Massachusetts ladies in blue.

This is Besone's ninth year as head hockey coach at State. He was hockey coach at Michigan Tech prior to coming to MSU. A letterwinner in hockey and football at the University of IP, Besone also participated in those sports as a professional.

Some of the other athletes around campus are a portion of the participants in the state's "Tow Tow" and "Pants" both which are now home in South Bend, Ind.

Arthur Thompson, a senior from Dearborn and Pauline House is in Brooklyn, N.Y., while a sophomore went to school in Boston, however.

Coach Jim Houston is a complete and determined man, a 1959 track football teacher, coming from Massachusetts furnished Besone's fresh squad with two defensemen, Dan Daley from Waukesha and Jack Painter from Boston. Painter also was a track-and-fielder last fall.

The fresh painters, who play every Tuesday and Friday afternoon, go to exercises in intramural activities and a weekly scrimmage for the varsity.

Return Fight? Ingo Says No, D'Amato Yes

HOLLYWOOD, Fla. (UPI) — Heavyweight champion Ingemar Johansson and Floyd Patterson's manager disagreed Wednesday on whether there is a commitment by the Swede for a return match with Patterson, the man being dehorned.

"There is nothing committed on my behalf," said Johansson. Ingo also said he thought Patterson might split with D'Amato, and that a title fight with light heavyweight champion Archie Moore might bring a bigger gate.

In New York, D'Amato said positively will be a Johnson-Patterson return fight.

"There is a legal contract for the return fight," said D'Amato. "And I am positive the fight will be held in June. The card was bought from the press promoters by Roy Cohn's organization. Cohn is a lawyer with a reputation. I'm sure he wouldn't say anything unless it was true."

Ga. Tech Cager Gets Dollar Fine

ATLANTA (UPI) — Georgia Tech basketball star Dave Denton and two other Tech students received suspended 30-day Wednesday for scalping tickets at the Tech-Kentucky basketball game Monday night.

Municipal Judge James Webb accepted no contest pleas to the charges from Denton and two other students.

The judge said Denton has achieved national recognition as a basketball player — Tech is sixth in the nation in the Associated Press poll — and added in his opinion there was nothing at all in this case to detract from his standing.
