That all freshmen and sophomores be permitted to take as many unexcused absences a term as the student is carrying credit-hours that same term, or an a basis that averages the usual number of credit-hours a term.

That the present system of allowing unlimited "cut" rivileges to students having a "B" average be extended to the freshmen and sophomores.

That all juniors and seniors have unlimited absence privileges.

That the penalty of negative credits for exceeding that allowance would remain, possibly being made even more drastic in view of the greater generosity of the proposal.
