Administrative officials of Michigan State college have been cleared of charges preferred against them in a petition presented to the county court by John Wendell Bird, residing at address, August 14, 1932, by an opinion handed down yesterday by Judge LeRoy W. Carr of the Ingham county court after an extensive one-man grand jury trial. Judge Carr states that he could find no violation of law in any of the six cases cited in the petition and concluded to acquit them.

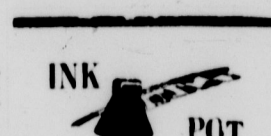

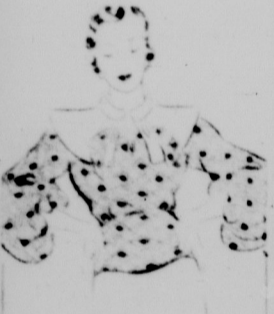
