State Fails To Maintain Early Lead

Defeat is Fifth in Row for Spartans; Michigan is Next.

Disgraced by two successive setbacks during the last three days, Michigan State's basketball team was back home today hoping for the best in its game with Michigan here Saturday night.

The Spartans followed up the 22-17 loss at Wisconsin last Saturday by dropping a 27-21 decision to Butler University at Indianapolis last night. The double reversal ran State's string of consecutive defeats to five.

State hasn't won a game since it turned back Syracuse here on January 29. Since then Northwestern, Hawaii All-Stars, Hope, Wisconsin and Butler have taken the Spartans into camp.

Against Butler last night, the Spartans held on valiantly. They led 14-13 at the end of the first half, but went into their usual late slump in the second half. In winning, Butler beat State for the fourth straight time. The Indiana club is still to lose a game to the Spartans.
